ELIGIBILITY RULES:

Any graduating Senior High School student, or College/Trade School student, providing his or her amateur status is still maintained, is eligible to make application for this scholarship, providing the student meets the following requirements:

A. Student must file this application, furnished by the Scholarship Fund Board of Trustees, giving complete information as required thereon, before March 1st of the year that application is being filed. Application must be given to a member of the Scholarship Board, or mailed to the Scholarship Selection Chairperson, as listed in this paperwork.

- B. Student must have unimpaired amateur standing in ALL athletics.
- C. Student must be a member of a bowling league certified by the USBC, in the Sarasota-Manatee County area. Must have held membership for at least the last two (2) years, and must be a member in good standing for the current season. Must have bowled at least 50 percent of the current bowling season.
- D. Must carry at least a 2.5 grade point average in the currently enrolled school. It is further required that the student be in good standing in both the community and the school system.
- E. High School students applying for this application should have proof of at least 20 volunteer hours that have had something to do with bowling as in helping at tournaments, during league sessions, or any bowling functions (fundraisers, golf tournaments, etc). These hours, must be documented by league officials, or any bowling officials from the events. This documentation must be attached to this application. *********
- F. College/ Trade school students applying for additional funds must maintain an average of 2.5, or better. An applicant attending an out of state school must maintain a legal residence in the state of Florida. First year scholarship requests will be awarded before any additional funds will be given out.

IF YOU COMPLY WITH THE ABOVE REQUIREMENTS, PLEASE PROCEED WITH THIS APPLICATION:

REMEMBER - DEADLINE IS MARCH 1ST OF EACH YEAR

1. Fill out all pages entirely. You, and your coach must sign in all appropriate places.

2. Have your bowling coach/league Director fill out the Coach's evaluation sheet entirely and sign it. This person cannot be a family member.

3. Have your school counselor, or another School Official fill out the Counselor's evaluation page entirely, and sign it.

4. Submit a type-written, double-spaced essay of a minimum 250 words, stating why you wish to attend College/ Trade School, and what your future plans are. Please be VERY specific. This essay will be an important part of the application process. Topics to be covered should include: School you wish to attend, any of the objectives including the majors you are going for, how you will use your degree in the future, and any future desires or goals. Also include how bowling may have had a part in your decisions for your future.

5. Send ALL forms, together with a recent transcript of your grades, to the Scholarship Selection Chairperson whose name and address is listed below. Make sure that your Bowling Volunteer List is also enclosed.

6. Be sure that ALL forms are completed and signed. Any incomplete applications will result in points being taken away, when considering the awards.

ALL FORMS MUST BE IN THE HANDS OF THE COMMITTEE CHAIRPERSON, BY MARCH 1ST OF EACH YEAR.
