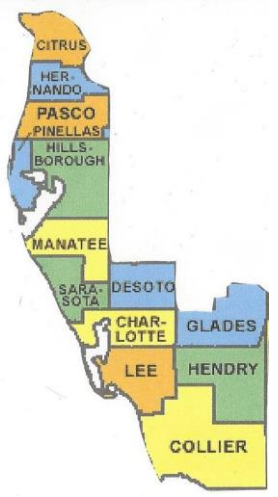

Tournament Rules

1. All USBC rules and regulations will govern this tournament in addition to the following tournament rules.
2. All entrants must be a current member of USBC. A 2025 -2026 USBC card must be presented at check-in. Should a bowler be unable to show their individual USBC sanction card, \$30.00 will be collected from the player for USBC membership dues. Youth bowlers (age 16 or more) are allowed to enter the singles event only, with winnings deposited into their smart account.
3. **ENTERING AVERAGES:** All entrants will use their highest 2025-2026 USBC winter average of 21 or more games. Any bowler without an average on BOWL.COM, may use their highest 2026 summer league average of 21 or more games, providing proof of average at check in. All others will have to bowl scratch. **All entrants, with average adjustments for tournaments must report prior to bowling, or risk being disqualified and forfeiting entry fee.**
 - A. The tournament committee reserves the right to adjust any bowler's average upward prior to their participation in the tournament. Failure to use the proper average the tournament Director will adjust the average and will base prize winnings on the submitted average if higher. **Rule 319A-2 (Ten Pin Rule) and Rule 319d (prize winnings) will be waived** for this tournament. **(Sport bowling averages will be adjusted according to Rule 203.)**
4. **HANDICAP:** 90% of 240
5. The tournament management has the right to add or delete a squad time. With no addition or deletion after 2 PM on August 9th.
6. Blind scores and pacers will not be permitted. Late bowlers will start scoring in the frame in progress upon their arrival, receiving zero for any missed frames.
7. All prize money will be returned 100% on a ratio of at least one (1) prize for each eight (8) entries in each event.
8. Fees will not be refunded after entry forms and fees have been received and a definite squad assigned.
9. In the event of a tie for championship in any event, money will be equally divided and awarded.
10. **Virtual Doubles Event:** An optional Virtual Doubles event is offered for an extra fee of **\$30.00 PER DOUBLES**. Must bowl in the SINGLES event to be eligible, and your score for the singles event will be used for your Virtual Doubles event. (ONLY THREE GAMES WILL BE BOWLED, SINGLES SCORES ARE USED FOR THE OPTIONAL VIRTUAL DOUBLES EVENT.) Bowl with the same, or as many doubles as you wish, providing they are bowling the singles event on the same squad, but you may only cash once with the same partner.
PLEASE ENTER AND PAY FOR DOUBLES AT CHECK IN FOR YOUR SQUAD.
11. WALK IN & MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION WELCOME WITH LANES AVAILABLE.
12. **DRESS CODE:** All bowlers must wear a shirt with sleeves and collar. Slacks, Shorts, Skirts & Jeans with a neat clean appearance will be allowed. The following apparel is **NOT PERMITTED:** Tank tops, Halter-tops or any clothing with inappropriate writing, language, or graphics. No headgear allowed during competition.

Entries accepted up until 30 minutes prior to each scheduled squad, subject to lane availability.

Brackets will be available.
